c. Riders without adequate Insurance Cover pay \$10 for Liability Only cover for the duration of the event. (Not personal Medical) and complete the Participant Waiver.

- d. PCAV club member cards must be inspected at the secretary's office before riding.
- e. PCAV Insurance Policy specifically states anyone not following PCAV Rules may be left uninsured.
2. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
3. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition, divide any class, alter times and refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
4. Competitors may ride more than one horse, subject to the conditions of PCAV Handbook of By-laws multiple horse rules. 6. Helmets must be PCAV compliant. Spot checks may occur.
5. Horses must be at least age four (ridden classes), no stallions, colts or rigs.
6. Gear Check: required for all PCAV riders before competition riding time. Medical Armbands: must be worn by all PCAV competitors.
7. Dogs are prohibited, without exception. Penalty elimination of associated competitor.
8. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCAV Handbook of ByLaws.
9. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.

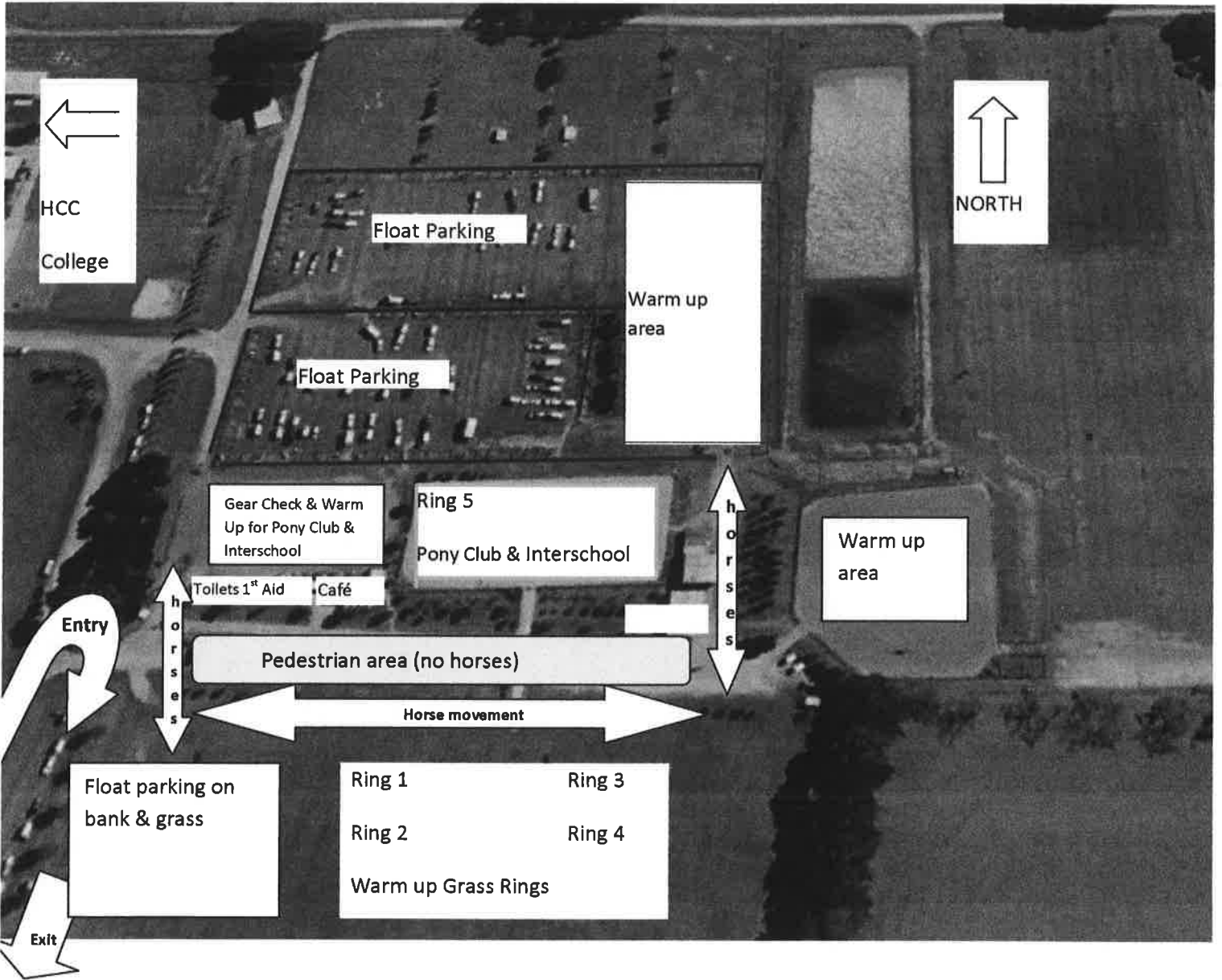

OFF THE TRACK SERIES – QUALIFIERS REGULATIONS

1. Open to all thoroughbreds unraced or raced 4 years and over, over 14.2 hands who are registered with RISA (Racing Information Services Australia). Registrations will be checked
2. Racing name to be used where appropriate. When entering if name is different to racing name, or if never raced please provide the following details (if known)
 - Racing name
 - Brands, colour and markings
 - Microchip number
 - Life Number
 - Registration Certificate Number
3. Qualifying Shows must be affiliated with VAS Ltd
4. Qualifying classes will be judged ridden
5. Once a qualifier is won, the horses cannot compete in other qualifiers
6. All qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the Off the Track series Final to be held at the 2017 VAS Ltd Saddle Horse
7. Riders to be 14 years and over on day of qualifying show
8. To be judged as a good example of Thoroughbreds rather than riding horse/hunter types with the following being taken into consideration:
 - Thoroughbred qualities
 - Conformation
 - Manners, paces and performance
 - Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes are allowed
9. Judges decision is final in qualifiers and final
10. Qualifier Prizes: \$50, sash, card and Racing Victoria Prize Pack

OFF THE TRACK FINAL

1. To have qualified at a Qualifying Show
2. Horse to be entered in racing name where possible
3. Expected to walk, trot and canter with change of rein
Competitors will be asked to do an individual workout and show walk, trot and canter on both reins finishing with a halt and salute to the judge/s
4. Other regulations for Final
 - In the event of one rider going through to the Final with more than one horse they must nominate a substitute rider
 - An exhibitor may not knowingly exhibit a horse that has been bred, sold, leased or produced by the judge or his/her employer
 - An exhibitor may not show a horse judged by any member of his/her immediate family
 - An exhibitor may not show under a judge that they have produced an equine for within the last 24 months
5. Entry Fee – if horse is entered in other classes at the VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships no entry fee applies. If only entering in Off the Track Final entry fee of \$44 applies
6. Prizes: Winner - \$1000, sash & rug, Runner Up - \$500 & sash, Final 8 - sash

There is a significant risk that serious injury or death may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event and freely assume all such risks, even if arising from the negligence of PCAV and/or the event organiser / official.

I voluntarily participate at my own risk and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption.

I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify PCAV against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst riding and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet at all times while riding and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless and agree not to sue the proprietors of the Pony Club Association of Victoria and/or the event organiser, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, state bodies, affiliated clubs and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise.

Effect of this Document - I have had sufficient opportunity to read this release of liability and assumption of risk agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and sign it freely and voluntarily without inducement of any kind. I understand that my signature to this document constitutes a complete and unconditional release of all liability of the Releasees, to the greatest extent allowed by law in the event of me and/or the children under my care, suffering injury or death.

In consideration of your accepting my participation, I hereby undertake to indemnify the organising body against all claims, losses, suits and damages made against or suffered by the organising body by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any rider, driver, trainer or attendant whilst he/she is attending, riding, driving or otherwise handling any horse so entered or any other horse owned or entered by me, and I agree that any act or omission on the part of such rider, driver, handler or attendant found in any action against you to be negligent shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purpose of any claim under this indemnity.

Further, I agree to abide by the Rules & Conditions and current Rule Book as laid down by the Pony Club Association of Victoria and/or contained in any official event schedule and I also agree to abide by all of the Event Venue rules regarding use of their centre and its facilities.
